Steve joined the Royal Navy as a Weapons Engineer in 1979. He has been involved in cold war patrols in the Iceland/Faeroes gap, humanitarian relief operations (including the Boxing Day Tsunami) and patrol duties during the Balkan conflict and Iran/Iraq war. In 2007 Steve became the Executive Secretary of the Naval Christian Fellowship which supports Christians in the RN, Royal Marines and Royal Fleet Auxiliary. Steve became the Operations Director of CVM in 2013 and also works for Edge, Chesterfield.

DAVE ALLAN



Dave grew up in Brisbane, and has been married to Paula for 37 years. After studying theology in the USA for 5 years, Dave and Paula returned to Australia, where he took on the role of a Baptist Pastor and was in Pastoral ministry for 10 years seeing churches grow and people come to the Lord. After 10 years, Dave burnt out and went through depression, where he eventually started his own coaching and consultancy business, which has now been operating for 20 years. Today, he runs a class in spiritual formation with ACOM, assesses church planters readiness for ministry, coaches in church teams and with Pastors, and consults with senior leaders of NFP organisations in leadership coaching, training and staff development.
