



We applied for the grant with a view to add security cameras, a boom gate at the front, and an upgrade to the campground lighting with new LED lights. Thankfully, MTCC was successful, and work has now been completed on the boom gate and security cameras with the campground lighting to be changed over beginning in July.



## **Grounds Update:** Tamborine life Centre

In the last newsletter we were introducing the subject of an internal staircase for TLC, as well as internal bathrooms.

Now...we can safely say that Jack, Bert and team are the jolly-best chippies / plumbers in QLD(!)not only did they get the job done beautifully, but it was also completed the MORNING OF Easter Convention...meaning the lucky people at TLC got to enjoy these fresh facilities for the convention.

The renovations at TLC began in October 2023. The plans were drawn up by Bert Van Lieshout. Bert worked on the stairs at home and brought all the parts and fitted them in quickly after cutting the hole in the floor upstairs. The men's bathroom was then demolished back to the studs and then refitted with all new plumbing, tiles, showers, toilets, hand basins and countertops. Bert had help from Jack Visser, Norm and Christine Turtle, Ken Cairns, Peter Witten, and Joel Prange. Moreover, during this time, the outside was given a fresh paint job courtesy of Cyrus Muradi and his brother. The ladies' bathroom was next and was finished just before Easter. This time it was mainly Jack and Bert working on the bathrooms with a hand from all those mentioned above. Also, Bert had the help of his wife Irma - she was doing all the finishing touches on the paint. The bathrooms and stairs are a welcome change for all those guests staying at this venue.

As you can see in these photos, TLC boasts a mesmerising easterly view of the hinterland and distant Gold Coast high-rises, meaning it gets some of the most stunning sunrises on Mt Tamborine. Now, thanks to our hard-working team, it is a much more accessible accomodation for guests, with internal facilities meaning they don't have to venture outdoors at night!



With guest speaker Tony Rinaudo, World Vision and author of 'The Forest Underground - Hope for a Planet in Crisis'

Known around the world as The Forest Maker, Tony Rinaudo has won several international awards for his work helping to transform millions of hectares of unproductive, degraded landscapes, and in the process transforming millions lives. Tony is undeniably an environmental hero making a positive impact on food security, environmental sustainability, and resilience for thousands of vulnerable communities around the world. Tony's method, called Farmer Managed Natural Regeneration (FMNR) and developed in Niger is now reaping benefits in at least 24 counties around the world. Tony is married to Liz, who has partnered with him on this journey, and their story is the subject of a book and film released in 2023.

In Sept 2024 we have the privilege of being able to hear Tony's story first hand at MTCC, and how his and Liz's lifework is underpinned by their Christian faith as they share the good news and hope of all creation.
